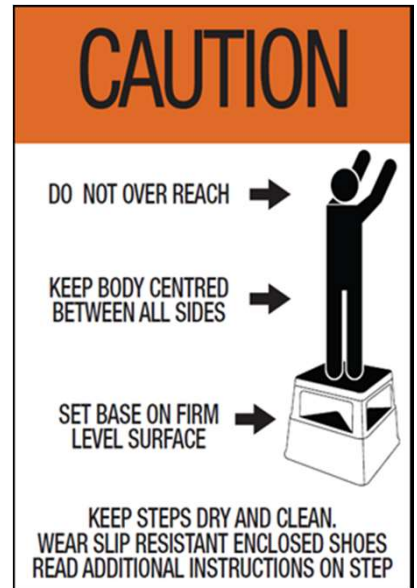
Inspection

- Inspect Step Stool upon receipt and before each use. Never climb a damaged or broken Step Stool.
- Keep Step Stool clean and free from dirt, grease, oil and other slippery materials. Keep your shoes clean.
- Replace damaged, worn or missing rubber feet and step tread as required to ensure safety.
- All parts must be in good working order. Never make temporary repairs of damaged or missing parts.



Safe Use Of Your Step Stool

- Do not push/roll step while someone is standing on it.
- Do not over-reach. Keep your body centered on Step Stool. Do not lean sideways.
- Face Step Stool when ascending/descending. Move Step Stool as needed.
- Wear fully enclosed slip resistant shoes.
- Place Step Stool on a firm level surface.
- The Step Stool is designed for one person use only, including materials or tools. Do not exceed max load rating of 150kg.
- Never leave Step Stool unattended – children may ascend and fall.
- Do not use the Step Stool if you tire easily, or are subject to fainting spells, or using medicine, alcohol or drugs or are physically handicapped.
- Do not place Step Stool on unstable bases to gain additional height.
- Do not place in front of door opening towards.



Proper Care & Storage

- Store in a safe and dry place out of weather.
- Keep clean and free of all foreign material.
- Examine for any damaged, worn or missing parts.
- Keep steps dry and clean.
